Summer Schedule

If you would like to change your child's schedule for any reason this summer, please let Jenny know as soon as possible.

Facts about Moms for Mother's Day:

- The average Mom will have changed approximately 7,300 diapers by the time her baby reaches age two!
- Typically, the first sound a baby vocalizes is the 'ma' sound. So it makes sense that in almost every language, the word for mother begins with the letter 'M' or is some iteration of the 'ma' sound.
- The fetal heart races faster when hearing its mother's voice vs. a stranger's voice. A mother's voice also eases older children's stress just as much as a real-life hug. The sound of mom's voice lowers a child's stress hormone, cortisol, and raises their level of oxytocin, a hormone linked with love and bonding.

Mothering is a privilege but it is also hard work! When my children were young, I often took solace in Isaiah 40:11 "He tends his flock like a shepherd: He gathers the lambs in his arms and carries them close to his heart; he gently leads those that have young." All of us have some idea that we aren't living up to a standard of perfection, especially with parenting. But did you see that? God is especially gentle with his sheep that have young ones. He knows how hard it is. He is a gentle, loving father. Let him carry you close to his heart this month!
